

# Changes to CBIP's Constitution

## Background

The Incorporated Societies Act 2022 (the 2022 Act) came into force on 5 October 2023. The 2022 Act modernises the laws and the way societies need to operate. Changes to the 2022 Act led to a rewrite of CBIP Constitution to ensure compliance with the new legislation.

CBIP's Board used the Constitution Builder tool provided by the New Zealand Companies Office to prepare the revised Constitution, Revision 06. The draft Constitution 2022 Revision 6.0 was reviewed by CBIP's lawyer for compliance with the 2022 Act.
